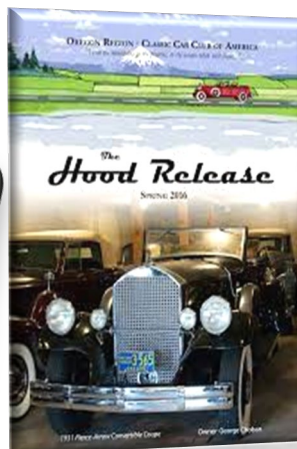
Event Details and Club Info
