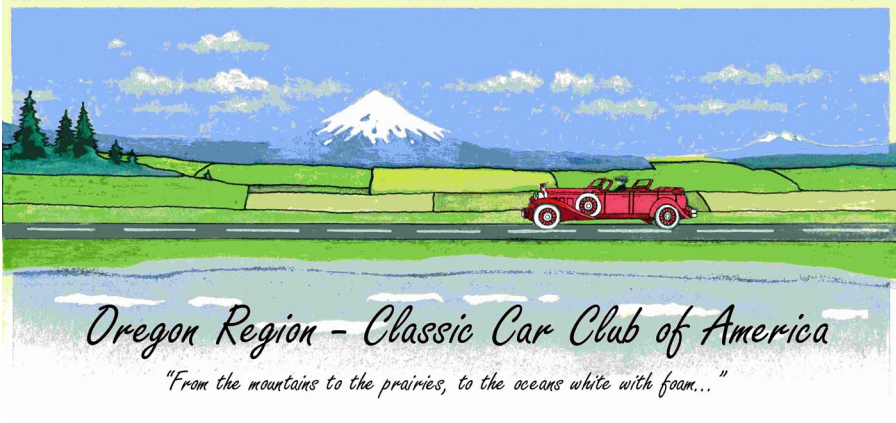

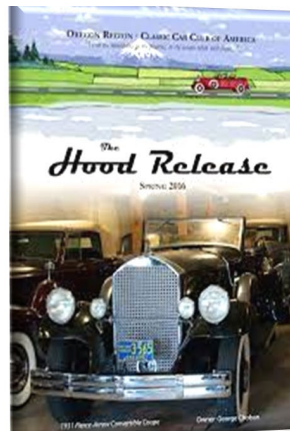
Big Jerry!
